Rules	The event will be governed by the rules as defined in <i>The Racing Rules of Sailing</i> , the prescriptions of the Royal Yachting Association and the BSA Sailing Instructions (December 2017).
Entries	The event will be open to all members of BSA and all visitors who are members of the Heron Dinghy Class Association. All competing boats shall hold a valid measurement certificate (or Log Book) and comply with the class rules.
Entry fee	£10 for all visitors
Registration	On Saturday 12 th May, before the first start
Briefing	10:15 on the day, outside the Pop-Up Café. Extra briefings may be held at the discretion of the Race Officer.
Schedule of races	It is hoped to run three races. No warning signals will be given after 16:00.
First start	Not before 11:00
Sailing Instructions	These will be available on the day and also at http://bewlsailing.club/Events/Open-Meetings .
Starting procedure	Rule 26 will apply. Single-handed and crewed boats will start together.
Scoring and results	<p>The results will be calculated on handicap. Different handicaps will be used for single-handed and double-handed boats.</p> <p>The scoring system will be as indicated in RRS Appendix A RYA 2017-2020.</p> <p>Any boat which is a lap behind the first finisher will be required to cross the finishing line and will be scored on average lap times.</p> <p>Two races to count</p>
Prizes	The number of prizes will depend on the number of entries.
Catering	Light lunches and beverages will be available from the Pop-Up Café.
